
Our mission it to promote self-sufficiency and provide assistance to those experiencing housing instability.

Almost Home operates the only <u>Emergency Shelter</u> in Brighton and one of only four in Adams County. We have room in our shelter to allow for six families to stay while working through their journey of homelessness to self-sufficiency and obtaining affordable housing.

GED & ESL Classes



Almost Home provides <u>Rental Assistance</u> to families in need. This essential program provides funds that help to ensure families on the brink of homelessness remain in their home.



Almost Home provides <u>Utilities Assistance</u> for those who find themselves behind or with a shut-off notice. Keeping the light and heat on for a family provides a basic necessity for a functioning household.
