COVID-19

Brighton, CO – COVID-19 (Coronavirus) is an evolving situation in the United States and in Colorado. The COVID-19 outbreak presents specific risks to the homelessness sector and Almost Home, Inc. is taking recommended precautions to ensure the safety of our staff and clients.

Outside of the health implications that COVID-19 brings to our community, there are also potential financial ramifications to households in our community. The programs and services Almost Home, Inc. provides are essential to the overall health and wellbeing of our clients and we want to inform the community that Almost Home, Inc. will remain open and will continue to provide Emergency Assistance to households at risk of or experiencing homelessness. Our services are critical to ensure that households can remain housed and have a safe place to stay.

Almost Home, Inc. is following the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended strategies for our offices, Emergency Shelter and staff. Almost Home, Inc. is actively encouraging and requiring staff that are sick to stay home, performing routine cleanings of the office and Emergency Shelter, and is distributing CDC guidance to our clients. In addition, Almost Home, Inc. has posted educational information at entrances and in strategic locations within our facilities to provide instruction on hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene, and cough etiquette.

Almost Home, Inc. will continue to monitor the evolving situation and adjust our response to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our clients and staff as needed. Should Almost Home, Inc. need to adjust our response, we will provide updated information to the community at that time.
