PROGRAMS & SERVICES



Housing Stability Program

Our Housing Stability Program provides emergency assistance and short-term case management to households at risk of eviction, foreclosure or utility shut-off.



Emergency Family Shelter

Our Family Emergency Shelter provides assistance to families experiencing literal homelessness. While in our Emergency Shelter families work towards self-sufficiency and securing permanent housing.



Rapid Re-Housing Programs

Our Rapid Re-Housing Programs provide rental assistance and ongoing supportive, home-based case management services to help clients achieve housing stability and long-term self-sustainability.



Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP)

Our Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP) provides motel vouchers to those experiencing literal homelessness during periods of inclement weather.



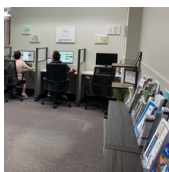
Respite Housing Program

Our Respite Housing Program provides quick diversion services for situational homelessness which includes motel vouchers for a 2-week stay (flexible length or households fleeing domestic violence).



Street Outreach Program

Our Street Outreach Program provides engagement and case management to connect people experiencing unsheltered homelessness to housing, shelter, and other critical services.



Housing Navigation Center (HNC)

Our Housing Navigation Center (HNC) provides assistance to walk-in participants experiencing housing instability with on-site resource navigation, referrals to our programs and partner organizations, and resources including access to computers, printing, mail services and food and hygiene kits.



No matter if you've supported Almost Home for years or are just getting to know us, we all share the same goal – to come together as a community to prevent and confront homelessness. Almost Home provides compassionate, innovative solutions to help individuals and families facing housing instability across Adams, Broomfield, and southern Weld Counties.

After more than four years of living unsheltered and struggling to survive, two siblings were given a second chance when Almost Home reached out unexpectedly. Their case manager helped them leave their campsite in Fort Collins and move into a safe, pet-friendly apartment in Greeley – a moment that marked the start of their journey toward stability and healing. Though the transition came with challenges, Almost Home remained by their side, giving them the time, compassion, and support they needed to rebuild their lives.

Today, they are thriving, sober, and deeply rooted in the Greeley community they now call home. One looks forward to retirement, while the other hopes to advocate for local pet owners in need. They credit Almost Home for believing in them when they couldn't believe in themselves – helping them rediscover their worth, rebuild their future, and embrace the truth that "it's not always bad things that happen."

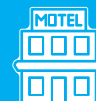
\$15,000
