



SEVERE WEATHER ACTIVATION PROGRAM



WHAT IS SWAP?

The Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP) is a program that activates during inclement weather and provides life-saving measures for people experiencing unsheltered homelessness. SWAP will assess households and administer hotel vouchers directly to enrolled households when the weather poses a threat to the well-being and lives of people sleeping or living outdoors.

WHO IS SWAP FOR?

SWAP serves people experiencing unsheltered homelessness in Adams and Broomfield Counties. Strong ties to Adams or Broomfield County must be established to be able to receive a voucher. An in-person assessment is required to enroll with SWAP.

WHEN IS SWAP ACTIVATED?

SWAP will activate when weather conditions reach:

- 32°F and below and wet (rain or snow) or
- 20°F below and dry.

WHERE CAN PEOPLE GO FOR SWAP SERVICES?

Hotel vouchers will be distributed Mondays-Thursdays from 10am - 2pm or until vouchers run out. Vouchers WILL NOT be given Fridays-Sundays. You must get a voucher in the county where you are enrolled.

- Adams County will not have a central intake location. Voucher distribution will happen through outreach only in Adams County.
- The Broomfield County intake location is Holy Trinity Anglican Church, 36 Garden Center Dr, Broomfield, CO.
