



SEVERE WEATHER ACTIVATION PROGRAM



WHAT IS SWAP?

The Severe Weather Activation Plan (SWAP) is a program that provides life-saving measures for people experiencing unsheltered homelessness. The assessment process may include referral to shelter, a hotel/motel stay, or severe weather supplies.

WHO IS SWAP FOR?

SWAP serves people experiencing unsheltered homelessness in Adams and Broomfield Counties. SWAP will assess households and administer hotel/motel vouchers directly to households as the weather poses a threat to the well-being and lives of people sleeping or living outdoors. SWAP participants must be connected to Adams or Broomfield County in order to be eligible for a SWAP voucher.

WHEN IS SWAP ACTIVATED?

SWAP will activate when weather conditions reach 32°F and below and wet (rain or snow) or 20°F below and dry.

WHERE CAN PEOPLE GO FOR SWAP SERVICES?

An in-person assessment is required. On the first day of every activation, Intake Day, voucher distribution will happen at both Adams County's and Broomfield County's designated intake locations. Adams County location- Crossroads Community Center, 10451 Huron St., Northglenn, CO, and Broomfield County location- Holy Trinity Anglican Church, 36 Garden Center Dr., Broomfield, CO. Intake Days occur Mondays-Thursdays from 10am - 2pm. Vouchers WILL NOT be given Fridays-Sundays.

Limited vouchers will be available at intake locations, but the majority of vouchers will be distributed by outreach workers in the community. If you are an individual experiencing homelessness and connected with an outreach worker, please stay in communication with them for higher likelihood of receiving a voucher.
